24/01526/S73A Application to vary condition 02 (approved Drawings) to change the external wall materials of the dwelling and bat roost/pergola relating to planning consent 21/02583/FUL; Erect dwelling (demolish existing agricultural building), form access and driveway. Land opposite Greenlands Farm, Charlton Musgrove. On a proposal from Councillor Moore, seconded by Councillor Rochford, Council voted to support the application. 4 for, 1 against.

APP/E3335/D/24/3344586 Appeal regarding planning application 24/00353/HOU, Stokeford Farm, Stoney Stoke Wincanton BA9 8HR. Council resolved to respond to the appeal stating they strongly stand by their previous comments regarding the original application.

Council discussed the email from a concerned resident regarding the footpath and fencing on the land adjacent to Heatherwood, Charlton Musgrove. After discussion and noting the residents' concerns, Council agreed to write to Highways regarding the footpath and to write to planning to ask why the approved planning application has varied from a hedge to wooden fencing.
