

# Website Accessibility

Charlton Musgrove Parish Council is committed to ensuring digital accessibility for people with disabilities. We are continually improving the user experience for everyone and applying the relevant accessibility standards.

## Measures to support accessibility

The [Web Content Accessibility Guidelines \(WCAG\)](#) defines requirements for designers and developers to improve accessibility for people with disabilities. It defines three levels of conformance: Level A, Level AA, and Level AAA. <https://charltonmusgrovepc.org.uk/> is fully conformant with WCAG 2.2 level AA.

## Technical specifications

Accessibility of <https://charltonmusgrovepc.org.uk/> relies on the following technologies to work with the particular combination of web browser and any assistive technologies or plugins installed on your computer:

- HTML
- CSS
- JavaScript

These technologies are relied upon for conformance with the accessibility standards used.

## Issues with PDFs and other documents

Our older PDFs and Word documents might not meet accessibility standards – for example, they may not be marked up so they're accessible to a screen reader. The accessibility regulations [don't require us to fix PDFs or other documents published before 23 September 2018](#) if they're not essential to providing our services. All new PDFs or Word documents we publish to meet accessibility standards.

Charlton Musgrove Parish Council assessed the accessibility of <https://charltonmusgrovepc.org.uk/> by the following approaches:





These checks highlight opportunities to [improve the accessibility of your web app](#). Automatic detection can only detect a subset of issues and does not guarantee the accessibility of your web app, so [manual testing](#) is also encouraged.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS TO MANUALLY CHECK (10)

Hide

- Interactive controls are keyboard focusable
- Interactive elements indicate their purpose and state
- The page has a logical tab order
- Visual order on the page follows DOM order
- User focus is not accidentally trapped in a region
- The user's focus is directed to new content added to the page
- HTML5 landmark elements are used to improve navigation
- Offscreen content is hidden from assistive technology
- Custom controls have associated labels
